

Register to Vote in Kansas!

Part 1: Sign up at the Department of Motor Vehicles, on-line at www.voteks.org or <https://www.kdor.org/voterregistration/>,
Or at the County Clerk's office.

Part 2: Find your birth certificate! (You can order a free one from Kansas Vital Statistics if you were born in Kansas. Find link at : <http://www.gotvoterid.com/proof-of-citizenship.html#evidence>

Part 3: Make a copy of your birth certificate and send it to the County Clerk or take a picture and email/text the County Clerk's Office, (In Riley County, use this information: 110 Court House Plaza, Manhattan KS 66502. Email to: voterinfo@rileycountyks.gov. Fax # 785-537-6394, or phone: 785-317-0467

(Do not send your original document)

Note: In Kansas, if you don't do this, you aren't registered!!

Part 4: Check on-line to make sure you are REALLY registered! (You will get a card notifying you when your registration is complete and telling you where to vote. (You can't vote just anywhere!) You can check at www.voteks.org or at <http://www.rileycountyks.gov/134/Review-Your-Voter-Information>

Part 5: You can vote early or wait to election day, but you MUST bring a government issued **Picture ID** (license, student ID card from state college or high school, (check the list!)

If you MOVE you need to re-register! (You may keep your family's address as a permanent residence, but then you must vote here or request an absentee ballot..)

Last Day to register for August 2 PRIMARY, July 12. Last Day to register for Nov. 8 GENERAL ELECTION, Oct. 18
